The field trip began promptly at 8:30 a.m. with enthusiastic students accompanied by their teachers and PTA members. The tiny tots were excited and ready for exploration and discovery. The trip included crossing and viewing multiple locations starting from Bank of India which aimed to introduce the idea of financial responsibility at an early age. Followed by the Petrol Pump where the students learned about fuels required for vehicles. Further the students crossed the creek- a serene natural spot that gave the children a chance to appreciate the beauty of nature. The students also observed the Nerul Police Station. Their teachers emphasised the importance role these police officers play to help protect the community.

The young learners enjoyed watching the fire engines at the Fire Station. The students also crossed and viewed Apollo Hospital, Nexus Seawoods mall and D mart supermarket. The children returned with a better understanding of their surroundings and the roles different organizations play in their daily lives.

On returning, the children created traffic signal through simple crafts activity which emphasised the significance of traffic rules and help the little ones to develop into morally and socially responsible citizens in the future.
