Report on Supermarket Visit – Cleanliness Awareness

What was done?

As part of experiential learning and to introduce the concept of *Cleanliness* in real-life settings, a field trip was organized for Sr. KG children to the **Supermarket at Inorbit Mall, Vashi**. Children **left school at 9:00 AM** and returned by **11:45 AM** after an engaging and insightful visit.

- Teachers guided the children effectively and reinforced key cleanliness concepts.

Suggestions

- Organize a "Clean Corner" display where children can bring pictures or items related to cleanliness.
- Conduct a role-play activity in class on how to keep different areas clean.
