## Social Outreach Programme for Classes IX to XII

Theme: Health and Micro Finance

Dear Students and Parents,

Students of Classes IX to XII will be taking part in the Social Outreach Programme conducted by the school in collaboration with the Social Development Cell of Stellar DB Academy. This Programme is mandatory as part of the Fourth Strand SEWA for CBSE Health and Physical Education Internal Assessment Grades. The activities planned for the same are as follows:

### Classes IX and XI

#### Instructions:

- Classes IX and XI will be going out for the Social Outreach Programme to Tata Nagar, Belapur on 11th October, 2025 with the Social Development Cell of Stellar DB Academy under the guidance of Mr. Mathew George.
- Students will report in the School in their House Uniform before 9:30 a.m. Departure to Belapur by 9:45 a.m. Reaching school at 2 p.m. Dispersal at 2:15 p.m.
- Each Class will be divided into two groups.
  - ✦ Group 1: Students of Red and Blue Houses
  - ✦ Group 2: Students of Green and Yellow Houses
- Each group will conduct a survey at the venue and spread awareness about health and micro finance.
- Students of Class IX (Performance and Voices) will be working with Class XII in the filming of the videos on spreading awareness about health during Zero Periods and Breaks.
- Students of Class XI (Survey Questions) will be working with Class XII in the creation of Survey Forms during Zero Periods and Breaks.
- The Survey Form and the material for the Outreach will be prepared by the students of Class XII during Zero Periods and breaks.

### Class X

#### Instructions:

- Each class is divided into 4 houses. Each house will work with a group of students of the Oratory on 15th October 2025.
- Students will report in the School before 3:45 p.m. Dispersal at 6:15 p.m.
- Class X A will conduct Collage on paper activity for students of Classes 1 and 2 of the Oratory.
- Class X C will conduct Diya painting activity for students of Classes 3 to 5 of the Oratory.
- Class X B will conduct Lantern making activity for students of Classes 6 to 8 of the Oratory.

- Class X D will conduct Toran making activity and Rangoli for students of classes 9 and 10 of the Oratory.
- Children of the Oratory will take home the decorations made in the school.

### Class XII

#### Instructions:

- Students of Class XII will prepare all the survey forms, videos and posters required for the Social Outreach programme. They will also plan the budget and conduct the analysis of the survey.
- All teachers will guide the students.
- Students will be divided into groups and assigned specific tasks.
- XII Science A Computer Science students will prepare survey forms.
- XII Science B will provide content for the videos on spreading awareness about health.
- XII Science C, XII Commerce and XII Humanities students will be divided into groups of 10 by Class Teachers and Subject Teachers for the following tasks:
  - ✚ Media Students will be divided into 2 groups. One group will record videos and the other will do the editing.
  - ✚ Yoga Students will work in a group and make Posters (A3 size) on the importance of yoga and exercises.
  - ✚ Psychology Students will work in a group and give content on Mental health.
  - ✚ Entrepreneurship Students will be divided into 2 groups. The first group will work on cleanliness and hygiene products. The second group will work on Health products.
  - ✚ Applied Mathematics students will work in a group and analyse the survey results. This group will prepare a dossier post the event and hand it over to Fr. Rector.
  - ✚ Financial Market Management students will be divided into 2 groups. The first group will work on the budget for the health activities. The second group will work on the budget for Diwali activities.
