Class-wise Activities & Rules (No Competition):

Class III, IV and V

ACTIVITY 1: Eco Friendly Diwali Poster Making

Materials Required: A4 size chart paper, Sketch pens / crayons / colour pencils, Glue and decorative waste materials (optional), Old magazines / newspapers (for creative reuse)

Instructions:

- 1. Students will design a poster based on the theme "Eco-Friendly Diwali".
- 2. The poster should promote messages like "Say No to Crackers", "Use Diya not Lights", "Celebrate Green Diwali" etc.

ACTIVITY 2: Mehandi Design Making

Materials Required: Mehandi cone, Tissue paper or wet wipes

Instructions:

Instructions:

- Students will design creative jewellery items such as earrings, bangles, necklaces, or rings.
- 2. They may use clay, quilling strips, or any other safe, eco-friendly materials.
- 3. Students will display the Jewellary on A4 size paper with the help of cello tape
