CCA – ECO CLAY CREATION

REPORT

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Dominic Savio Kindergarten conducted a Co-Curricular Activity (CCA) titled “Eco–Clay Creations” on 28th November 2025 for the students of Nursery, Jr. KG, and Sr. KG. The activity aimed to promote creativity, imagination, fine motor development, and hands-on learning among young learners.

In line with the school’s eco-friendly approach, students used **homemade flour-based clay** instead of plasticine. The initiative encouraged children to explore sustainable craft practices while strengthening finger muscles, improving hand-eye coordination, and boosting confidence through creative expression.

The activity was held during school hours in the respective classrooms. Each level worked on a theme connected to nature:

Nursery: Fruits

Jr. KG: Insects

Sr. KG: Aquatic Animals

Students enthusiastically shaped and moulded their colourful clay models using their hands and optional moulds or cutters. They displayed their creations on labelled writing pads as instructed. The classrooms were filled with excitement as children confidently showcased different objects from nature using their own imagination and creativity.

Parents contributed by preparing the homemade clay as per the recipe provided, ensuring active collaboration between school and home. The activity successfully fostered joyful learning, sensory exploration, and creative thinking.
